- Section offerings remain consistent with slight variations to flex for student demand
- Class Fill-Rates: has exceeded $100 \%$ for the last six semesters; ranging from $105.38 \%$ to $140.71 \%$
- Productivity: has remained high
- Completion Rate: average in the mid to upper 80s
- Success Rate: This continues to be a major challenge. Over the last four semesters there has been a slight increase in the success rate each semester which coupled with the transition to the new TMC provide opportunities for improving the health of this program
