Opportunity Analysis: (Successes, new curriculum development, alternative delivery mechanisms, interdisciplinary strategies, etc.)
The new History TMC is in the process of being implemented. It is a leaner version of the degree and represents a major realignment for the program. It also provides new opportunities to revitalize the major. SLOs and PLO assessments of current offerings will facilitate continuous program improvements by refining offerings and retiring marginal courses.
The BSS Department is expanding and updating its already impressive Media Library which features scores of History titles. This Library will be made available to the campus community as well as the communities-at-large that we serve.
With the tearing down of the 500 Building, which housed many of the History classes, there is a need for a dedicated History room that will accommodate the maps and other History specific items.
Summary of Program "Health" Evaluation: (Including consideration of size, score, productivity and quality of outcomes)
The four "core" classes fulfill Area D requirements for IVC graduation and 120 and 121 fulfill state requirements for American Institutions and IVC and the CSUs.
As evidenced by the high fill-rates and large section offerings, History is a strong, viable, relevant, and growing major on this campus. This fact is somewhat obscured by the low success rate as also evidenced by only 7 degrees since Fall of 2009. The transition to the state-based TMC is anticipated to improve this outcome.
From Fall of 2009 up to Spring of 2012 the program averaged over 30 sections per semester, with above average productivity. Fill-rates regularly exceed 100%
Completion rates have varied considerable by course with a low of 50% per cent and high of 98%.
Success rates are a matter of concern, varying from 20% to 98%. Again, with the streamlined TMC and more frequent assessments, this should improve.
SLOs are being regularly assessed and the data is being used to improve course content and course relevancy and selection.
