The IVC Upward Bound team coordinated another successful six-week Summer Academy and Summer Bridge which took place at IVC and UCSD. UB students attended various rigorous courses that prepared them for higher education. Students took courses in Pre-calculus, Algebra 2, Geometry, English Literature and English Composition. Students will receive high school credits for completing these courses. In addition, UB students participated in hands-on and engaging STEM activities during the Chemistry and Engineering (Robotics) courses. The last 2 weeks were offered at University of CA, San Diego located in La Jolla. The students got to experience the new apartments located in Roosevelt College at UCSD. Students who completed the 6 weeks of class were invited to fun field trips to Sea World, Balboa Park Museums, La Jolla Shores and Six Flags.
