Parliamentarian Guzman is asking for everyone’s assistance during this event. This event will be discussed with more detail during the ASG planning meeting and will be finalized at the next ASG meeting.

The Welcome Back BBQ/Club Day is scheduled to take place next Thursday, February 23, 2017. 600 hot dogs will be served including a limited number of vegetarian franks.

The Food Pantry was discussed. Secretary Deol stated that Vice-President of Student Services, Dr. Martha Garcia expressed the need to expand the food pantry program to eventually include a distribution center for the community. Senators expressed some concerns in regards to the countywide distribution center. President Bermudez asked for everyone to survey a few students in every class and write down the concerns from students in regards to this item.

Dean Martinez-Inzunza suggests that Dr. Garcia should be invited to the next ASG meeting to clarify the program and share the students’ concerns.

Senator Chavez suggested the Community Distribution Center should be operated late on Friday afternoons, which will lessen the impact on the student population.

VP Barajas encourages all ASG Commission to recruit students outside ASG to assist with the planning and coordination of events.
