618 Increase staffing levels of the Campus Safety Officers

The number of Campus Safety Officers has reduced by 40% since 2014. The number of Campus Safety Officers both paid student workers and volunteers needs to be increased. In prior years there were 15 Campus Safety Officers currently there are 8. This reduction in CSO's has impacted the mission of the Campus Safety and Parking Control Office. The shortage of trained Campus Safety Officers has required reducing the number Campus Safety Officers per shift and increased the length of time it takes to respond to a call for service. This is due to a Campus Safety Officer being on one side of the campus and responding to a call for assistance at the other side of campus. Additional there have been occasions where the Campus Safety Officers' were engaged in an incident and there was another call for service that comes in at the same time. This situation requires the Campus Safety to determine which call for service has the priority and then the calls are handled with the most serious having the first response.

714 Implementation and continuation of CampusClarity and LawRoom on-line student/employee training programs

Full integration and continuation of the on-line training programs, CampusClarity and LawRoom. The CampusClarity on-line training program is for current and returning students to receive information which is designed to assist them in the academic efforts while also providing personal choice information about drugs and alcohol use and abuse. The LawRoom on-line training program is for faculty and staff and provides training areas that will allow them to provide a more effective job product with a focus on the college working environment and assist them in being more successful employees.
