1243	Improve tracking and data integrity The EMT and especially the Paramedic program are required to track the data specific to individual students. Data includes typical demographics, number of times each required skill was performed, field evaluations, and National Registry success rates. This has become more tedious and difficult even with excel databases. It now requires a database system designed for EMS programs. This was a STRONG recommendation during the last accreditation.
1244	Medical Director contract Current Medical Director has submitted his notice of retirement. Another physician must be identified as the program Medical Director to remain accredited. While we may be able to keep the same contract amount of \$14,000, it is highly likely that for the first time IVC will have to pay out the full amount of the contract annually. Originally the Medical Director was compensated at \$70/hour. That amount was set many many years ago. The proposed contract will be 1/2 the time, but double the hourly rate so total amount will not exceed \$14,000 (hopefully).
