

IMMEDIATE RELEASE EL CENTRO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Imperial County)

The unemployment rate in the Imperial County was 19.2 percent in October 2018, down from a revised 19.3 percent in September 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 19.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
