Inputting Comprehensive Program Review using Nuventive

Comprehensive Program review has three areas to be completed:


Past Objectives – Provide update to 2020-21 objectives

Future Objectives - Development of 2022-23 objectives

Present – Do a current program data analysis of academic areas or SWOT analysis for service areas

Below is a guide of the inputting process:

1. Log in to Nuventive through IVC single sign-on: https://sso.imperial.edu, use IVC email and password, and click on Nuventive



2. The Nuventinve Screen will open on a specific Program, Department, or Service Area that you have been assigned access to.




To toggle between programs or departments, click on the arrow on the green arrow above and select the program or department you are conducting a program review for. If your department or program is missing from the menu, please contact jose.carrillo@imperial.edu or yolanda.catano@imperial.edu.

Past Objectives – Provide update to 2020-21 objectives

3. We will begin with the first section of the comprehensive program review:

Click on the three lines, next to the program (orange arrow below), we will refer to these lines as the hamburger menu. Click on program review (red arrow below).



4. Click on objectives and updates as shown on the green arrow above. The objectives screen will show all past, present and future objectives for your area on Nuventive. These objectives were all migrated from SPOL for the 2020-21 and 2021-22 years; please send an email to jose.carrillo@imperial.edu or yolanda.catano@imperial.edu. if you had previous SPOL objectives that are not showing on Nuventive. The current task is to provide an update for all the 2020-21 objectives. Click on the three dots on any objective that has the implementation year of 2021-21 (green arrow below) and open as shown below (red arrow below):




5. Click on the mapping tab on the top of the screen.

This section will require your objectives to be aligned to the 2021-30 IVC Comprehensive Master Plan. You can access the plan at: https://tinyurl.com/IVCCMP2130

Pages 2.4-2.11 list the Strategic Goals and objectives all objectives need to map and aligned to.


Please review all Strategic Goals and objectives listed under the mapping tab and click on the H,M, and L, to determine if your objective has a High, Medium or Low impact on achieving the Institutional Strategic Goals as shown by the green arrow below. If your objective does not impact a specific goal, please leave blank and proceed to next one as shown by the green arrow. After completing this section, click on save on the right upper corner and close.



Once you map your objectives to the Strategic Goals, please click on the arrow and map your objective to the Vision for Success goals as shown below. After you select your objective's impact on the Vision for Success goal, save and close.



6. Click on the updates tab of the objective. This is where you need to provide an update for your 2020-21 objective by clicking on the green plus sign below as shown by the arrow.



Complete the update tab, by selecting 2020-21 reporting period, then choose the status update that best reflects your objective status under conclusion, and provide a writing narrative of the developments of your 2020-21 objectives. Feel free to add any documents, reports, presentations or any supporting evidence by clicking the green + sign under related documents. Please click save and close to continue.

- 7. Continue to follow steps 4-6 on all objectives that have an implementation year of 2020-21.
- 8. For objectives under implementation year 2021-22, please make sure that these objectives are still relevant, and feel free to make any modifications; you will be reporting updates on these objectives Fall 2022.

Future Goals – Development of 2022-23 objectives

9. Click on program review and proceed to Objectives and updates. The current task is to develop new objectives for the 2022-23 academic cycle. These objectives will serve as the link to budget enhancement requests, which will be covered later on this guide. If you are carrying forward objectives from previous year, please see step 10.


Click on the green + to create a new objective as shown by the arrow below:



A new screen will open up with three new tabs, objective description, mapping, and updates.

Under objective description, complete the objective name, description; choose 2022-23 for implementation year. Write 2-5 tasks that will help you in outlining the required steps to complete the objective, and write how the objective will be measured/evaluated and if there are any additional departments or programs at IVC that will be required to assist you in completing this task. After you complete all sections, save and close. If you have other new tasks, follow the steps above in step 9 until you enter all your new objectives.


10. If you have old objectives you wish to carry forward to 2022-23, go to Program Review and under Objectives and Update, open the objective you wish to move to 2022-23. Under implementation years, add year 2022-23 as shown with the arrow below. Please make sure you add the required tasks, the objective measurement tool is completed, and the responsible parties are filled in. Save and close the objective.




If your objectives do not require a budget enhancement, proceed to Step 14 for Academic Program Review or Step 17 for Service Area Program Review.

Budget Enhancement Requests

11. If any of your 2022-23 objectives require a budget enhancement request, under Program Review, please go to Budget Enhancement Requests as shown by the arrow below. As in previous year, you will tie next funding cycle objectives to budget enhancement requests.



12. Once a new screen open, click on the green + sign to create a new budget enhancement request.




Complete all areas for the budget enhancement request. The requested year should be 2022-23. The name/title of the description should be key words to identify your request, the description of the request should include any clarifying information (if needed) on the type of request, and then include the dollar amount, and the justification should include how this request will improve your programs or fill your program needs. Please exclude all commas when inputting a dollar amount; otherwise, an error message will not let you save.

Under the budget enhancement request, choose High, Medium, or Low to label your request. The next question asks you provide a ranking for each of your requests. This is your chance to rank your requests, and provide a level of priority among those by the same department or unit. An example is a program requesting and ranking the following three requests: 1) computer \$2000 2) travel funds \$2500 and 3) computer software \$1000, and only \$2500 become available, the items ranked higher are to be funded first.

Please make sure you select the appropriate category for your request, if you have any questions about a specific category please email Stacey.browning@imperial.edu with any questions. Choose the funding type that best describes your request, then chose the expense type and indicate if there is a legal obligation as part of your request. Save and close.

13. Once the budget enhancement request details are inputted, open the mapping tab as shown below with the arrow.



The list of all of your objectives will open up. Please select the objective that your budget enhancement request is supporting.


This mapping is important so that when all the budget enhancement requests are prioritized, the corresponding objective is extracted with the request and may provide additional information when making a decision. Save and close.

14. If you have other budget enhancement requests, repeat step 11-12. Once you completed entering all your budget enhancement request, click on the hamburger menu, go to budget enhancement requests, and you should see all the request that will go for ranking and funding consideration. Please make sure that the 2022-23 year is on the request.

Comprehensive Program Review Academic Data Analysis and Service Area SWOT Analysis


Present – Do a current program data analysis of academic areas or SWOT analysis for service areas

14. Every three years all program need to complete a comprehensive program review. If your program needs to complete a program. For the service area program review calendar click here, for the academic program review schedule click here. In the hamburger menu, select Comprehensive Program Review. Depending on whether you complete an academic or service area program review, your questions will be different.




Academic Area Program Review - Present

15. Once every three years academic programs will need to conduct a comprehensive analysis of enrollment and outcomes. Click on the green + arrow to begin entering your responses. Select 2021-22 as the cycle year.




16. Once you select the cycle year you will be prompted to enter an analysis of enrollment, fill rates, productivity, success/retention and degrees awarded.



You will see that a link to tableau will be visible on your right side of your screen. Click on the tableau dashboard screen and you will be prompted to log in in to Tableau. We have limited Tableau licenses in our initial launch. If you do not have access to Tableau, and need data, please contact oliver.zambrano@imperial.edu or yolanda.catano@imperial.edu.

Nuventive will allow you to open a Tableau dashboard next to your comprehensive program review questions. You can use the Microsoft snipping tool, or the snipping tool of your choice to print screen and attach to your analysis.





17. Once every three years, service area programs will need to conduct a comprehensive analysis utilizing a SWOT analysis. Click on the green + arrow to begin entering your responses. Select 2021-22 as the cycle year.



18. Once you select the cycle year you will be prompted to enter your SWOT analysis questions.



Please complete all areas of the SWOT analysis as well as the linkage to Vision for Success questions, and how you utilized your SAO assessment to develop your planning objectives.
