

eCAMINOS ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

About Us

The eCAMINOS (engineering pathways) program is designed to support engineering students' aspirations by providing (a) need-based scholarships, (b) resources to develop and maintain their engineering portfolios, (c) dedicated mentorship and advising from faculty, peers, and academic advisors, and (d) access to internships and research opportunities.



<u>Scholarship</u>: Scholars will receive varying amounts of scholarships up to \$15,000 per year based on unmet financial need.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for the eCAMINOS (engineering pathways) scholarship, scholars must satisfy the following criteria:

- Be admitted to the University of Arizona College of Engineering
- Be a new undergraduate
- Maintain at least half-time enrollment (i.e., a minimum of six units per semester)
- Plan to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree in an engineering discipline
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (<u>FAFSA</u>®) for every year of participation in eCAMINOS program
- Demonstrate financial need after accounting for all other sources of financial aid (as determined by the University of Arizona Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid)
- Be a citizen of the United States, permanent resident, national of the United States, or refugee (as defined by section 101(a) or section 207 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
