



eCAMINOS ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

About Us

The eCAMINOS (engineering pathways) program is designed to support engineering students' aspirations by providing (a) need-based scholarships, (b) resources to develop and maintain their engineering portfolios, (c) dedicated mentorship and advising from faculty, peers, and academic advisors, and (d) access to internships and research opportunities.



Scholarship: Scholars will receive varying amounts of scholarships up to \$15,000 per year based on unmet financial need.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for the eCAMINOS (engineering pathways) scholarship, scholars must satisfy the following criteria:

- Be admitted to the University of Arizona College of Engineering
- Be a new undergraduate
- Maintain at least half-time enrollment (i.e., a minimum of six units per semester)
- Plan to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree in an engineering discipline
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) for every year of participation in eCAMINOS program
- Demonstrate financial need after accounting for all other sources of financial aid (as determined by the University of Arizona Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid)
- Be a citizen of the United States, permanent resident, national of the United States, or refugee (as defined by section 101(a) or section 207 of the Immigration and Nationality Act)
